1. SAFETY

2. INTRODUCTION

For use with AK4560D pump station. Heavy-duty steel and powder coating finish for corrosion resistance. Four roller fairlead allows smooth running of hose whatever the angle of hose or mounting position of reel. Multi position ratchet lock with fully enclosed spring. Includes 1.5mtr connection hose for connecting reel to pump.

4. MOUNTING

- 4.1. Mount the reel to a wall or bench using appropriate fixings (not supplied).
- 4.2. Connect the 1.5mtr hose from the centre reel connection to the AK4560D pump station.
- 4.3. Connect a dispensing gun/meter to the outlet connection.



5. OPERATION

- 5.1. Pull the hose at a steady pace, a clicking noise from the ratchet will be heard, when the hose is at the desired length, gently release the pressure and the hose will lock into position.
- 5.2. To retract the hose, pull the hose out a short distance and release the hose will now rewind.
- WARNING! DO NOT** let go of the hose, guide it back until it is fully retracted. Failure to do this may damage the gun or metering device on the end of the hose.

6. MAINTENANCE

- WARNING!** Before attempting maintenance or inspection vent any pressure remaining in the hose and empty hose of oil etc.
- 6.1. To ensure reliable operation, inspect, clean hose and casing regularly. **DO NOT** spray or wet the product but clean with a damp cloth.
- ✗ **DO NOT** use solvents or detergents as these may cause permanent damage.
- 6.2. The hose reel does not require special maintenance as it is lubricated for life. If the product needs attention, consult your nearest authorised service agent.
- WARNING! DO NOT attempt to loosen or remove any part of the product. Replacement of the supply hose should be carried out by skilled personnel only, contact your nearest authorised service agent.**
- 6.3. Store in a cool, dry, childproof place.
