1. SAFETY

- ❑ **WARNING!** Ensure Health & Safety, local authority, and general workshop practice regulations are adhered to when using this trolley.
- * **DO NOT** overload the trolley. 25kg capacity per shelf.
- * **DO NOT** drop loads on to shelves.
- * **DO NOT** place hot (above 100°C) items on to shelves.
- ✓ Load shelves with the heaviest items on the lower shelves.
- ✓ Use the trolley in a suitable work area.
- ✓ Keep the work area clean, uncluttered and ensure there is adequate lighting.
- ✓ Keep the trolley clean and tidy in accordance with good workshop practice.
- * **DO NOT** use the trolley for any purpose other than that for which it is designed.
- * **DO NOT** stand on the trolley, use it as a ladder or allow others to ride on the trolley.
- ✓ Use the wheel locks to prevent the trolley from inadvertently moving.
- * **DO NOT** leave unattended, especially when loaded, unless the wheels are locked, chocked or the trolley otherwise secured.
- * **DO NOT** use trolley on uneven ground and **DO NOT** run over curbs or steps - use a ramp.
- * **DO NOT** use trolley if any part is significantly damaged, paying particular attention to the wheels.

2. INTRODUCTION

Folding composite garage workshop trolley with a 25kg capacity per shelf. Walls on all four sides to stop items from sliding off the trolley. Four large castors, two locking. Can also be used as a janitorial trolley. Folds up in seconds for easy storage when not in use.

4. ASSEMBLY

- 4.1. The trolley comes fully assembled.
- 4.2. Check all trays are present.
- 4.3. Check all fixings are in place and are operational.
- 4.4. Check castors are fully engaged in legs and they roll freely. Lightly lubricate if necessary.



5. OPERATION

- ❑ **WARNING:** When the unit is new the joints on the folding parts are likely to be stiff and will require significant effort to open and close. Beware of fingers and/or hands being pinched as the unit unfolds / folds. Use suitable PPE.

5.1. UNFOLDING (fig.1, fig.2)



- 5.1.1. Pull folded trolley apart initially using the handles (fig.1, fig.2).
- 5.1.2. Push locking bar (fig.1) down to lock in position.

5.2. FOLDING

- 5.2.1. Pull locking bar (fig.1) upwards.
- 5.2.2. Push frame together for final closure using handles (fig.1, fig.2).

5.3. STORAGE

- 5.3.1. The unit will stand upright when folded but it is recommended that it should be laid down to avoid being knocked over.
