## 2. INTRODUCTION

  4.2. Position insulating sheet to provide maximum protection to user (fig 1).
  - Insulating sheet can be fixed in place with insulated clamps or insulating PVC sticky tape, not supplied.



### 5. MAINTENANCE

5.1. If the insulating sheet becomes dirty, wash it with soap and water and dry thoroughly.
