# MOTORCYCLE DOLLY REAR WHEEL- LONG SIDE STAND TYPE.

# 1. SAFETY

- 1.1. Maintain the dolly in good condition (use an authorised service agent).
- 1.2. Replace or repair damaged parts. Use genuine parts only. Unauthorised parts may be dangerous and will invalidate the warranty.
- 1.3. Locate the dolly in a suitable work area. Keep area clean and tidy and free from unrelated materials, and ensure that there is adequate lighting.
- 1.4. Ensure that the floor is level and strong enough (preferably concrete) to take the weight of the dolly and the motorcycle.
  - **DO NOT** use the dolly on tarmacadam, as the surface may be unstable.
- 1.5. Keep the dolly clean for best and safest performance.
- 1.6. The maximum motorcycle weight is 300kg. **DO NOT** exceed this rated capacity.
- 1.7. Use appropriate straps to secure the motorcycle to the dolly when manoeuvring.
- 1.8. Pull rather than push the motorcycle when manoeuvring on the dolly to reduce the risk of pushing the motorcycle off its side stand.
- 1.9. Maintain correct balance and footing, **DO NOT** over reach. Ensure the floor is not slippery and wear non-slip shoes. Keep children and unauthorised persons away from the work area.
  - **DO NOT** use the dolly for a task it is not designed to perform.
  - **DO NOT** use the dolly if it is damaged.
  - DO NOT use the dolly when you are tired or under the influence of alcohol, drugs or intoxicating medication.
  - DO NOT allow untrained persons to use the dolly.
  - DO NOT make any modifications to the dolly.
- 1.10. Before storing in safe area, ensure that all parts are clean and free of grease and oil.

WARNING: The warnings, cautions and instructions in this manual cannot cover all possible conditions and situations that may occur. It must be understood that common sense and caution are factors which cannot be built into this product, but must be applied by the operator.

# 2. INTRODUCTION

Motorcycle dolly holds a single motorcycle or sports bike with side stand, weighing up to 300Kg. Enabling easy manoeuvrability around the workshop or garage. The front wheel stays in contact with the ground allowing the motorcycle to be steered into the desired position. Pivoting design allows flexibility in side stand designs.



# 4. ASSEMBLY

Part No	Description	QTY.
1.	Main Part	1.
2.	Aluminium Plate	1.
3.	Nut with Cap	6.
4.	Spring Washers	6.
5.	Flat Washer	6.
6.	Wheels With Brake	2.
7.	M12 Set Screw	1.
8.	Supporting Arm	1.
9.	Aluminium Plate	1.
10.	Wheels Without Brake	3.



- 4.1. Remove with care all contents from outer packaging and check parts against parts list. Ref. to fig.2
- 4.2. Place main part (1) on ground attach 2 Wheels with brakes (6) using Flat Washers(5), Spring Washers(4) and nuts with cap(3).
- Attach 2 Wheels(10) using Flat Washers(5), Spring Washers(4) and nuts with cap(3). 4.3.
- 4.4. Place Supporting Arm(8) on ground attach Wheel(10) using Flat Washer(5), Spring Washer(4) and nut with cap(3).
- Using M12 Set Screw, bolt Main Part(1) and Support Arm(8) together. The support arm can move in relatoionship to main part and can 4.5. be adjusted to position/design of side stand before bolt being thightened fully.

#### **OPERATION**

- WARNING! Ensure that you read, understand and apply the safety instructions before use.
- WARNING! DO NOT attempt to overload the dolly.
- 5.1. Loading.
- 5.1.1. Position the dolly in a suitable area, checking that the surface on which the dolly will be used is solid and flat.
- 5.1.2. Apply the brakes to the two wheels
- 5.1.3. Push the motorcycle on to the dolly positioning the rear wheel centrally on the main part and support with the side stand on the support arm adjust as required and fix in position by tightening set screw. Front wheel remains on ground.
- 5.1.4. Release the brakes to allow the dolly to be manoeuvred.
- Unloading 5.2.
- 5.2.1. Apply the brakes to the two wheels.
- 5.2.2. Holding handle bars lift side stand and remove the motorcycle from the dolly.
- Store the dolly in a safe, dry, childproof location with the 5.2.3. brakes on.



#### 6. **MAINTENANCE**

- 6.1. Before use, check the frame assembly and platform for cracks and damage.
- 6.2. Regularly check that all fasteners are tight.
- 6.3. Periodically lubricate the castors
