1. SAFETY

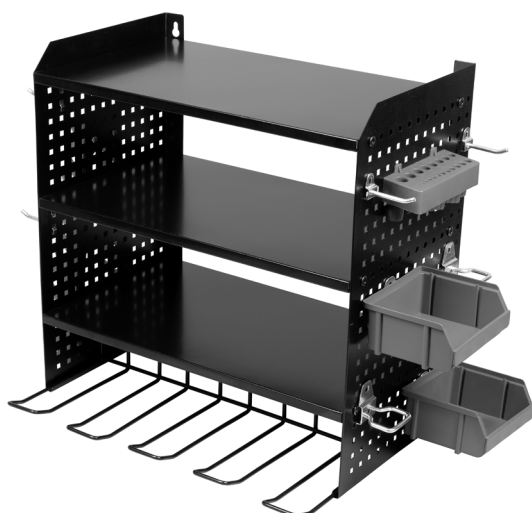

2. INTRODUCTION

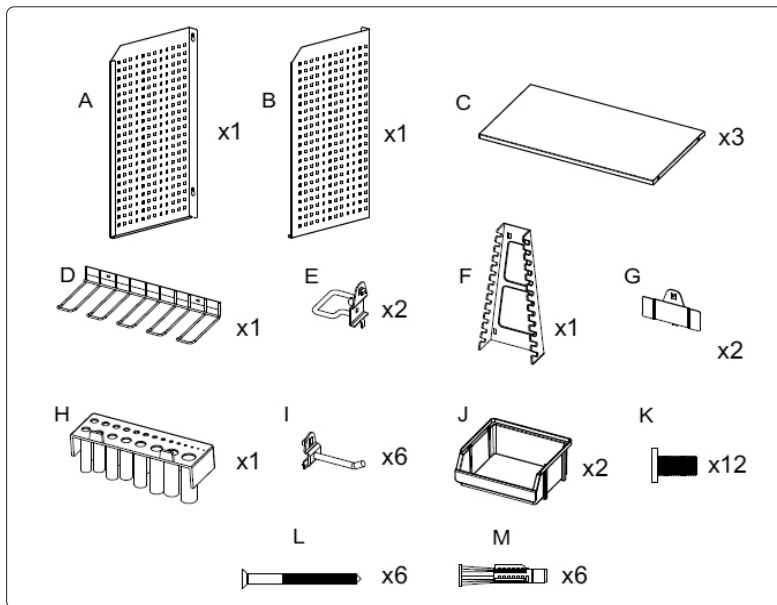

Note: The installation method on the right is for reference only. You can change the installation location based on your own needs.

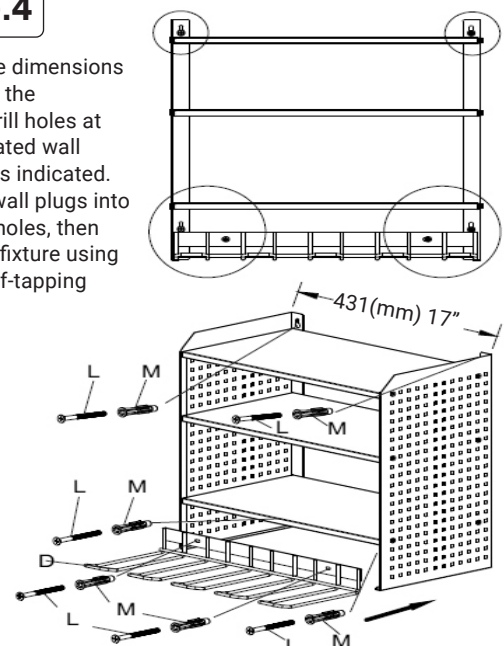

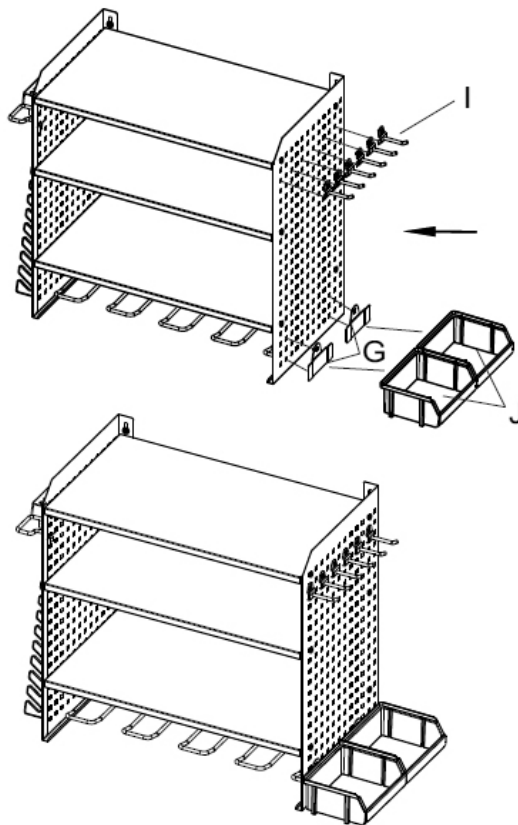

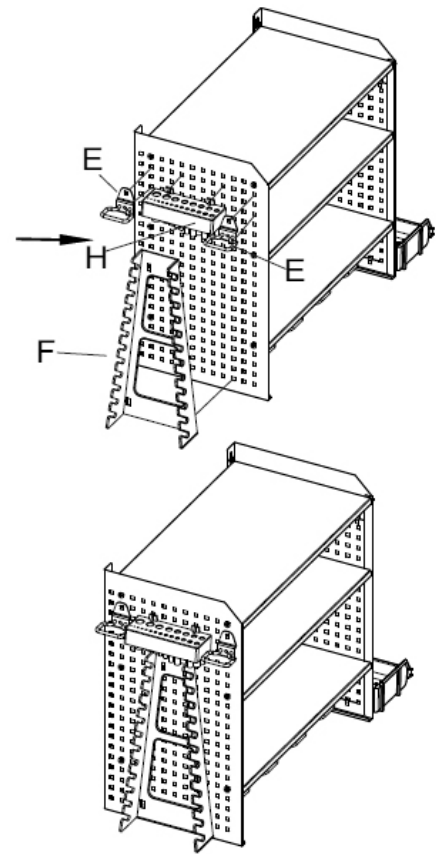
Refer to the dimensions provided in the drawing. Drill holes at the designated wall positions as indicated. Insert the wall plugs into the drilled holes, then secure the fixture using 4.5 mm self-tapping screws.

6. INSTALLATION

- 6.1. Rack can be installed onto a peg board (using nuts and bolts) or a wall.
- 6.2. If installing into a wall, ensure wall (and fixings) are able to support the weight of the rack and any tools stored upon it.
- 6.3. Hold rack in place to mark and then pre-drill holes.
- 6.4. Use fixings appropriate to the wall being used to fix the rack to.

7. MAINTENANCE

- 7.1. Regularly check fixings and mountings are firmly fitted and that the rigidity and security of the rack is not compromised.
- 7.2. Wipe clean with damp cloth.
 - ✗ **DO NOT** use chemical or abrasive cleaners as this may result in damage to the surface.
