4. OPERATION

- **4.1.** Position tool on joint.
- **4.2.** Tighten thrust bolt using a spanner or ratchet to apply tension to the vehicle's joint.
- 4.3. Strike vehicle joint with a hammer to shock joint loose. Several strikes to the joint may be necessary to loosen it sufficiently to be disassembled.
 NOTE: DO NOT strike the tool with a hammer or other heavy object.
- 4.4. A returned tool showing signs of abuse will be exempt from any Warranty claim.
